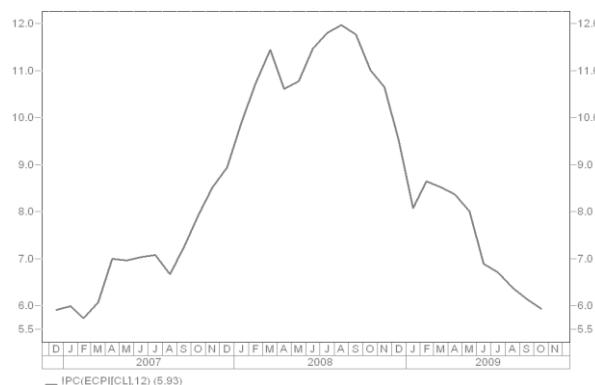

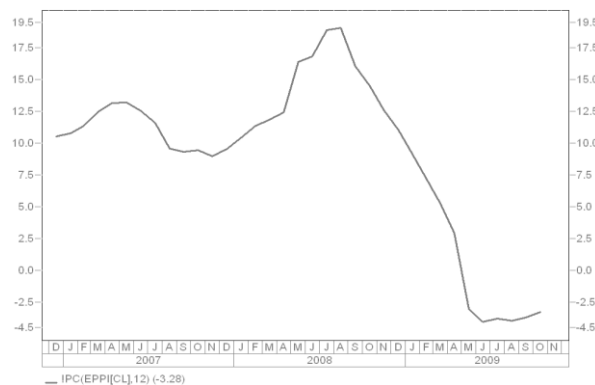
UK GDP, Quarterly
